



IS BAYER A COUNTERFEIT?

Apostle Paul

1. Came not in word only, but in power: 1 Thessalonians 1:5
 2. Had power to destroy: 2 Corinthians 13:10; Acts 13:6ff.
 3. Speech and preaching was in demonstration of the Spirit and power: 1 Corinthians 2:4
 4. Kingdom of God is not in word, but in power: 1 Corinthians 4:19,20.
 5. I write the commandment of the Lord: 1 Corinthians 14:37. Confirmed Mark 16:17-20.
 6. He ministered the Spirit and worked miracles: Galatians 3:5.
1. Comes to us in word only, with no power.
 2. Has no power, only strong vocal cords.
 3. Speech and preaching is with enticing words of man's wisdom: 1 Corinthians 2:4

If there are, they do not fit New Testament qualifications!

If there are not Apostles today, what passage teaches that
they and their signs [2 Corinthians 12:12] were to cease?

Who Removed Them?

Only Apostles Could Lay On Hands to Impart Miraculous Gifts

Acts 8:5-25

1. Phillip had miraculous gifts (v. 6) but could not impart them.
2. These people were baptized (v. 12) and had received the gift of the Holy Spirit promised in Acts 2:38-39 but could not do the miraculous (v. 16).
3. They were saved Christians for whatever period of time was required for Peter and John to come.

Conclusions

- ★ A man may be a complete Christian without miraculous gifts
Romans 1:11 • 1 Corinthians 12:29-30
- ★ Only Apostles could impart gifts and show signs of apostleship.
2 Corinthians 12:12
- ★ Without Apostles gifts could only be imparted by Holy Spirit Baptism.
