

believe that Jesus Christ is the son of God.

Fifth, we are commanded to **be baptized**. Baptism is not for babies, Mark 16:16 says one must believe before baptism. Acts 2:38 teaches that baptism is for the remission of sins; see also Acts 22:16. When we are baptized we are added to the one body or church (I Corinthians 12:13; Acts 2:47). Every example of conversion in the book of Acts mentions baptism. Many religious groups practice baptism but for the wrong reason.

Read these examples of conversion in the book of Acts. Have you done what the New Testament teaches in order to be saved? If not, you should obey the gospel of Christ today and find a faithful congregation of the church of Christ and worship and work with them.

WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

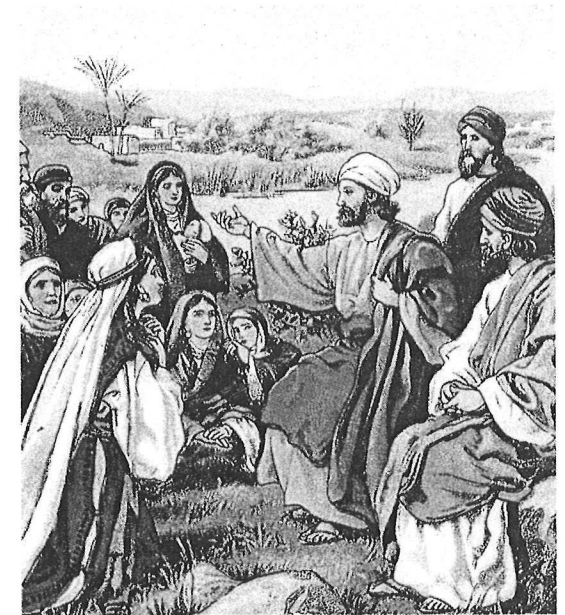
1. **Believe** that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God (Acts 8:37).
2. **Repent** of all sins (Luke 13:3; Acts 17:30).
3. **Confess** Christ as God's Son before men (Matt. 10:32-33)
4. Be buried by **baptism** (Rom. 6:4; Col. 2:12) "into Christ" (Gal. 3:27) "for the remission of sins" (Acts 2:38).
5. **Live faithful** unto death (Rom. 12:21; Rev. 2:10).
