An attractive, well illustrated and scriptural lesson holds attention and is long remembered. Most of what we learn comes through the sense of sight.

In January 1956 I published my first book, CHART SERMONS, and appreciate the reception they have had. A number of brethren are using the outlines and some are using charts that I have painted for them. It is my purpose to make charts simple and scriptural lessons that are attractive and well illustrated. In this book, CHART SERMONS VOL. II, I have endeavored to present lessons that will be profitable to sinner and saint and send forth these charts and outlines with a prayer that they will be helpful to those who labor in God's vineyard to lead the lost and erring to Christ and trust that they will be a help to all who may study them. While these arrangements are mine I am indebted to a number of brethren for thoughts and help they have given me.

These are photographs of charts that I have painted and use in my preaching. Two of these I illustrate with the use of electric bulbs that work in series and one with a battery motor that works a head back and forth. These are very effective. - D. The messenger was a men pleaser and wanted Micaiah to be one - "Speak that which is good..." - 1 Ki. 22:13.
- E. Micaiah would speak the Lord's word - 1 Ki. 22:14.

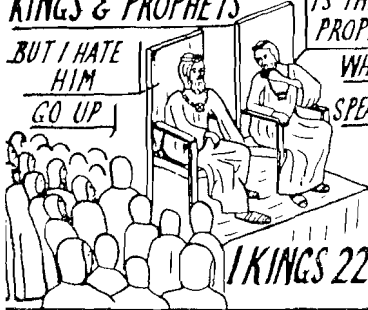
II. In New Testament Days

- A. The eunuch wanted help in understanding the Lord's word so he might comply with it - Acts 8:26-39.
 - B. Cornelius and his house wanted to hear all commanded of God - Acts 10:25-33 - A most commendable attitude that all should have.
 - C. Elymas wanted to turn away deputy from the truth - Acts 13:8.
 1. Compare to present day denominational preacher.
 - D. The deputy wanted to hear truth - Acts 13:7.
 - E. The Bereans searched for truth and believed - Acts 17:10-12.

BAPTISM TAUGHT BY PAUL

1 Cor. 1:10-17

Many want to make Paul say here that baptism is not important.
A study of Paul on baptism is very interesting.

I. From Acts We Learn

- A. That Paul was baptized to wash away his sins - Acts 9:18; 22:16.
- B. That as a result of his preaching Lydia, the jailor, the Corinthians, and the Ephesians were baptized - See chart.

II. Paul Wrote To Seven Churches

- A. To every one he spoke directly or indirectly on baptism.
- B. He wrote man is baptized into Christ and in doing so obeys the force of doctrine, that man is not baptized into the names of men, that man is baptized into one body, he speaks of baptism for the dead, that man puts on Christ in baptism, that there is one baptism, that the church has been cleansed with the washing of water, that men are buried in baptism, that all are to walk by the same rule, and that vengeance will be taken on those who do not obey - See chart for scriptures.

III. Paul Is Believed To Be The Author Of Hebrews

- A. Reference is made to the doctrine of baptism - Heb. 6:2.
- B. Their bodies were washed with pure water - Heb. 10:22.

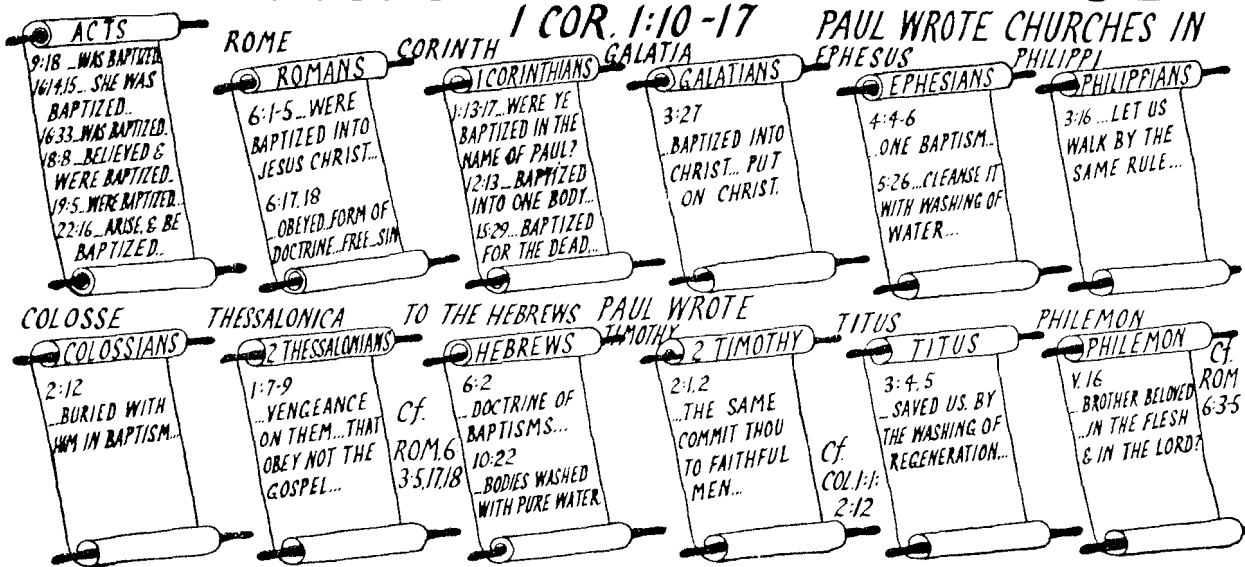
IV. Paul Wrote To Three Individuals

- A. Timothy was to commit the same things he had heard to faithful men. Baptism included - 2 Tim. 2:1,2 Cf. Col. 1:1; 2:12.
- B. To Titus - Lord saves by washing of regeneration - Tit. 3:4,5.
- C. He spoke of Philemon's brother in the Lord - Phil. 16 Cf. Rom. 6:3-5.

Paul was under the great commission like the others - Mk. 16:15,16.
Compare 1 Cor. 1:17 with Jo. 12:44.

CALLING ON THE LORD'S NAME

Acts 2:21; Rom.10:13

When one calls on the Lord's name he will be saved, but how call?

I. Is The Calling

- A. By prayer? Many say "Yes", but for what could one pray?
 1. Not for God's love - Jo. 3:16; Rom. 5:8.
 2. Not for God's grace - Tit. 2:11,12.
 3. Calling is not by prayer for many who so call will not enter heaven but only those who do the Father's will - Mt. 7:21.
- B. Calling on one's death bed, "O Lord, save me."?
 1. No, for one must do the Father's will - Mt. 7:21

II. A Comparison Of Scriptures

- A. In Rom. 10:13-17 Paul starts with salvation and goes back a step at a time showing how calling is done.
- B. In Mk. 16:15,16; Acts 2:37,38; Acts 22:16 the action starts with the going and advances one step at a time to salvation.
- C. Study the comparison carefully: Preacher goes, preaches - men hear, believe, call by obeying and are saved - Jo. 6:44,45; Heb. 5:8,9.
- D. To call is nothing less than doing Father's will - Mt. 7:21.
- E. The Father's will on baptism is - Lk. 7:30; Mk. 16:15,16; Jo. 8:28; 12:49.

III. One Must Obey Gospel

- A. To call is to obey gospel - Rom. 10:13-17.
- B. Man is to obey form of doctrine - Rom. 6:1-5,17,18.
 1. The doctrine is the death, burial and resurrection of Christ.
 2. The form is man's death to sin, burial in baptism and being raised to a new life.

II. Men Today Despise And Reject Christ's

- A. Authority preferring human teaching to God's word - Mt. 28:18-20; Jo. 5:26,27; 8:28; Col. 3:17.
- B. Church preferring denominations to the true church - Mt. 16:18; Col. 1:18; Eph. 1:22,23; 4:4-6; 5:23; 1 Pet. 2:5.
- C. Name preferring human names to the name Christ and the name Christian - Acts 4:12; Col. 3:17; Acts 11:26; 1 Pet. 4:16; Rom. 16:16.
- D. Gospel preferring their own way of salvation - Mk. 16:15,16; Rom. 1:16; 6:17,18; 10:16.
- E. Worship preferring worship after the doctrines and commandments of men to true worship - Jo. 4:23,24; Acts 2:42; Col. 3:16.
 - 1. There is vain worship - Mt. 15:8,9.
 - 2. There is ignorant worship - Acts 17:22,23.
 - 3. There is will worship - worship to please self - Col. 2:20.

I. The Modernist

B. One refused to baptize by immersion - Rom. 6:4; Col. 2:12.

II. The Fake Healer

A. Has his "healing" line - miracles passed - 1 Cor. 13:8-10.

B. Tells people to pray for salvation - Acts 22:16.

III. The Premillennialist

A. Says Christ not King now - Jo. 18:37; 1 Tim. 6:15.

B. Says kingdom yet future - Mk. 9:1; Acts 2.

IV. Catholicism

A. Teaches Bible not complete will of God and is a dead letter -2 Tim. 3:16,17; Jo. 6:63.

B. Teaches priests are other Christs, mediators - 1 Tim. 2:5.

V. Big Time Modern Evangelist

A. Urges joining church of choice - Mt. 16:18; Eph. 4:4; 1:22,23.

B. Says new birth is by faith alone - Jo. 3:5.

VI. Modern Denominationalist

A. Teaches justification by faith only - Js. 2:22-24.

B. Teaches infant baptism - Mk. 16:16 (Believer baptism).

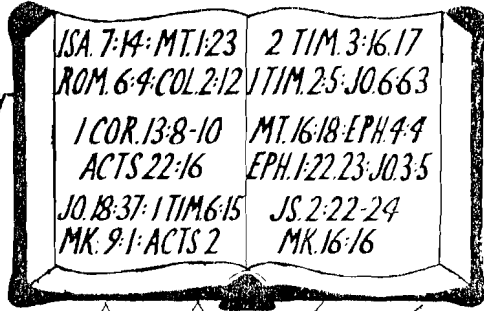

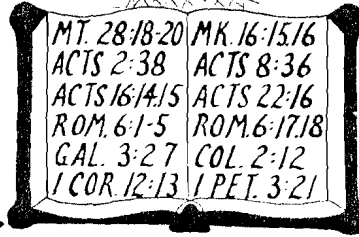
