DANGERS THE CHURCH FACES

Ephesians 6:10-18

- A. Ignorance - many members of the church now are not good students of the word.
- B. Neglectfulness - many grow careless in their duties to the Lord.
- C. Worldliness - the increasing popularity of worldliness and pleasure seeking is entangling more and more members of the Lord's body. Teaching is needed.
- D. There is constant danger of error coming in.
- E. Boastfulness - some now are very proud of "their many good works".
- F. Compromise - there is a desire on the part of a number to get along with the denominations and to become more like them.

II. Let Us Fight Against The Danger Of...

- A. Materialism - too much emphasis is put on material wealth. We must fight against the temptation to keep up with the world.
- B. Lukewarmness - materialism tends to bring on lukewarmness.
- C. Indifference - we must take a positive stand for the Lord and His way.
- D. The doctrine being corrupted with the ideas and ways of men.
- E. There is always the danger of apostasy with which to contend.

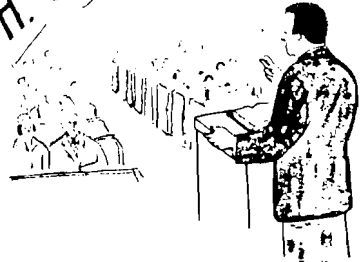

FAITH - DEAD OR ALIVE?

James 2:14-26

1. The doctrine of faith only is a very popular one. Many deny that man is required to do anything to be saved.
2. For our soul's sake let us make an impartial study of this subject from the Bible.

I. Dead Faith

- A. James says that faith only is a dead faith.
- B. Now contrast this statement of James with statements from the Baptist manual and the Methodist discipline.
- C. Faith only does not love and does not obey.
- D. Faith only is dead and therefore can do nothing.

II. Live Faith

- A. It takes live faith to love, work and obey.
- B. Such faith is perfected by its action.
- C. Live, loving, working, obedient faith justifies.
- D. Consider the examples of Noah, Abraham, about 3,000 on Pentecost and the eunuch. These people had live faith that caused them to obey the commands given them and they were rewarded.
- E. Other examples can be seen in the blind man washing his eyes, the sinner being baptized, Christians being faithful in their duties as Jesus commanded.

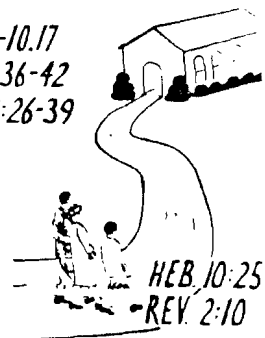

Luke 16:19-31

This lesson traces man through life, death, the resurrection, judgment and to eternity.

I. From Birth To Accountability

- A. Infants are innocent and safe. They do not inherit the sins of their parents.
- B. If they die as infants they will pass into Abraham's bosom to await the resurrection.
- C. When they learn right from wrong they then pass into the power of darkness.

II. Man's Possibilities

- A. Man can remain in the power of darkness all his life and pass at death into Tartarus.
- B. Man may hear and answer the Lord's precious invitation and be baptized into the kingdom of Christ.
- C. He may become careless and unfaithful and pass at death into Tartarus.
- D. He may be faithful all the rest of his life and at death pass into Abraham's bosom.

III. The Hadean World

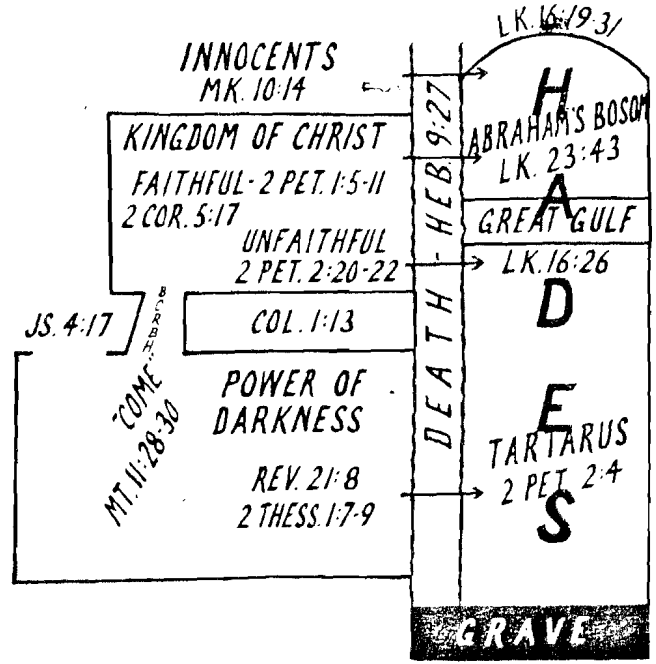
- A. Hades is the place of departed spirits - both the righteous and the unrighteous.
- B. The righteous are at peace in paradise or Abraham's bosom while the wicked are in torment separated from the righteous by a great gulf.

IV. The Judgment

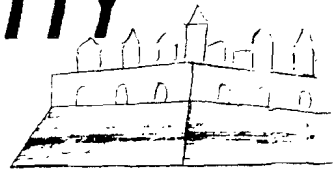
- A. There will be a great resurrection and a great judgment - a great separation.
- B. To the righteous the King will say, "Come ye blessed.." but to the wicked He will say, "Depart from Me, ye cursed," - some to heaven and others to hell.

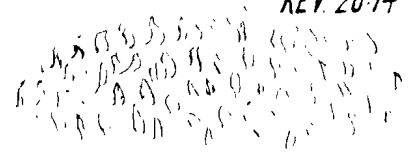

GOD'S POWER TO SAVE AND KEEP

- A. Their turning to God - leaving the darkness of sin and error.
- B. The gospel - it being preached - heard, believed and obeyed.
- C. Being baptized into Christ.
- D. When people obey these commands of the Lord they then are freed from sin.
- E. People are thus saved by God's power in the gospel.

II. People Are Kept Saved By...

- A. The power of God through faith. Man must believe and keep himself in the love of God by being faithful - believing to the saving of the soul.
- B. Continuing in the faith - fighting the good fight of faith.
- C. Pressing onward and upward for salvation that comes at the end of a life of faith.
- D. The crown of life comes after a faithful life.

IGNORANT OF GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS

Romans 10:1-3

1. There is much ignorance of God's word - God's plan of salvation.
 2. We refer to righteousness of God as His requirements - His commandments.
 - I. There Is Ignorance Of Who Is Saved
 - A. Some think that without time or effort for God they still will not be lost.
 - B. Many feel that any "good, honest, charitable" person will be saved.
 - C. Many follow their conscience or parents and think they can't go wrong.
 - D. Salvation is personal - one must act for himself - obey the gospel to be saved.
 - II. There Is Ignorance Of How One Is Saved
 - A. Some say by "faith only" or "through prayer", "while plowing" or "like thief".
 - B. Some think of salvation as something you catch - like it was a disease.
 - C. Many believe and follow anything their preachers or creeds say.
 - D. One is saved by obeying the gospel of Christ as the Bible teaches.
 - III. There Is Ignorance Of Where One Is Saved
 - A. Many will say, "the church doesn't save" while thinking they are safe in denominationalism. Some expect the Masonic lodge to save them.
 - B. The saved are in Christ - in His church, His body.
 - IV. There Is Ignorance Of How One Keeps Saved
 - A. Some think they are saved with no chance of ever being lost regardless of what.
 - B. The Bible teaches that faithfulness is necessary to keeping saved.

2. Some had this idea in Bible days and many do today.
 - I. Concern For God's Promises
 - A. Moses was worried about God's promise to feed all the Israelites.
 - B. Sarah laughed about God's promise that she would have a son. Brother N. B. Hardeman used to say she and Hagar formed the first Ladies Aid Society.
 - C. Men see no harm in ways they devise to help God fulfill His promises.
 - II. The Lord Asked Moses, "Is The Lord's Hand Waxed Short?"
 - A. God is Almighty - there is nothing lacking about Him nor His ability.
 - B. His hand was not short when He spoke the world into existence - made all things.
 - C. His hand was not short when He spared Noah from the flood or saved Israel.
 - D. Neither was it short when He provided salvation for man and purposed the church in Christ. Time would fail to tell of all His manifestations of power.
 - III. The Lord's Work Is Not Short
 - A. God's work and way perfect - complete - nothing is lacking or wanting.
 - B. God has provided sufficiency in the Saviour, the gospel plan, the church, the Scriptures and the work of the church but Catholics, denominationalists and many brethren don't think so and turn to their common sense for help.

1. The life of a Christian is compared to a race in which one engages to win.
2. We need to heed Paul's admonition and run as if there were to be only one winner and we are determined to be that one.

I. One Must Qualify For The Race

- A. Must strive lawfully. Must meet the Lord's requirements - hear, believe, repent, confess and be baptized.
- B. The devil tempts with a dead, do nothing faith - no obedience.

II. Run A Good Race - Look To Jesus - Keep Your Eye On The Crown

- A. Heed the Bible warnings of who the devil is after and how he works.
- B. Accept the help and encouragement of the Scriptures.
- C. Overcome temptations to the works of the flesh, worldliness, human orders, unfaithfulness, neglectfulness and shirking of individual responsibility.
- D. Add to faith virtue, knowledge, temperance, patience, godliness, brotherly kindness and charity.

 - B. The thief died under the law and before Christ's will and baptism became effective. He died before the church was established.
 - C., Christ will save the church. He died for the church.

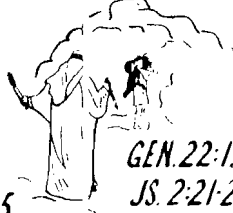

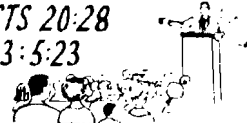
